## STUDENT CLASSIFICATION (REGULATION)

In accordance with the policy of the board of education, the following regulation shall govern student grade classification.

| Sophomores | 6 units or more |
| :--- | :--- |
| Juniors | 6 units or more |
| Seniors | 6 units or more |
| Graduation | 24 units or more |

All students must have 24 units to graduate (Includes units earned in the 9 th grade.) At least 18 units of the 24 units must be earned in the top three grades $(10,11,12)$.

All students must be enrolled in five solids except seniors attending afternoon college classes or involved in a workstudy program. Any student receiving an "I" in a semester will have one semester to make up the incomplete before it is changed to an "F."

Level 1 Student is working above level of other students.
Level $2 \quad$ Student is working on level.
Level 3 Student is working below level of other students.
Each quarter's grades on the report card will denote the level at which the student is working. The semester grade is the only grade recorded on the student's transcript.
