

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

All school activities must be scheduled through the office and placed on the official school calendar in the principal's office. The first activity recorded on the master calendar will always have priority. All activities should be requested as far in advance as possible (at least two weeks if possible). Exceptions may be made by the principal, but only for unusual circumstances.

All extracurricular activities, which are scheduled by the school, to be held on Wednesdays, shall terminate by 6:00 p.m. Students competing in activities must be eligible according to the rules of the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association.

The school reserves the right to set academic requirements for students participating in the extracurricular activities and to limit the number of days a student will be dismissed from school for these activities, but shall be no more than five full days in any one class per semester.

The Gracemont Board of Education believes that extracurricular activities are those activities that primarily involve student in other than classroom situations. The board believes that participation in such activities should be available only to those students who are performing acceptable work in all other school-related areas. Therefore, the superintendent is directed to establish a regulation, subject to approval of the board, governing participation in extracurricular activities.
