

**STUDENTS:  
FEES, FINES, AND CHARGES**

It is the goal of the Gracemont Board of Education to provide a free, appropriate, public education to all the children of this district. However, there are certain areas in which the payment of fees, fines, or charges may be required. The superintendent is directed to establish a regulation designating such areas and setting forth methods of payment.

The school will furnish textbooks and workbooks required by the teacher. The state places the responsibility for the care and return of the textbooks upon the parents and students. The parent or student must pay for any furnished books that are lost or damaged beyond reasonable wear. Student records may be held until lost or damaged textbooks are returned or replaced.
