

General Troubleshooting

Making computer monitor show on TV

Hook the S-video cable to TV.

Put TV on S-Video channel.

Right click on computer screen.

Choose Properties - Settings tab - Advanced - G-Force tab - Video.

The first drop down menu may say "single." If so, change to "Clone."

Show streaming video on your TV

1) Go to your desktop. Right-Click - Properties - Settings -

Advanced - Troubleshooting. Change the hardware acceleration to **HALF**.

2) Open Windows Media Player. On the menu bar, click View - Tools -

Options - Performance. See the window for Video Performance - Hardware

Acceleration. Change the hardware acceleration to HALF.

You can also check it on your media player when streaming a video. Just rightclick on the video - options - video acceleration (set to half if projecting).

Thumb or Flash Drive won't show up

Put the thumb drive in the USB slot you want to use.

Go to Control Panel --Performance and Maintenance --Administrative tools.

Open Computer Management.

Expand Storage (if needed) and select Disk Management.

You should see drives displayed at the bottom of this screen. Find your Thumb Drive (most likely labeled F:drive).

Right click on the thumb drive and select "Change Drive Letters and Paths" and select the drive of your choice.

(Z:drive is recommended.) You will get a warning message. Say OK.

Close the windows and open My Computer. The thumb drive should be visible.
