

AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

The aim of the scholarship awards system is to encourage students to strive for high achievement in scholarship and to reward those whose record most accurately reflects attainment. In keeping with this, the following general guidelines should apply:

1. All students will have the opportunity to win scholarship awards.
2. The factors deciding the awards should be clearly laid down and be as objective as possible.
3. Students should be made aware of the system to be used when they enter high school.
4. The relationship between the system and the relevant goals of the school should be clearly presented to students and parents.

This philosophy shall be reflected by the method used in determining class rank, honor students, valedictorian, and salutatorian.

In determining such honors, a weighted grade point system shall be used. The system of weighted grades shall be arrived at by a committee composed of at least two students, two teachers, one administrator, one counselor, and two parents. The system shall be reviewed for possible revision every year.
